The International City

Warner Robins earned its nickname "The International City" through decades of diversity shaped by Robins Air Force Base. Military families arrive from across the country and around the world, bringing a wide range of backgrounds, cultures, and faith traditions. The result is a community with deep Christian roots that also embraces a growing variety of religious expressions.

Whether you practice a majority or minority faith, you are likely to find a welcoming community here. Most worship options are located within Warner Robins itself, with additional choices just a short drive north along I-75 to Macon.





The Faith Landscape

Warner Robins sits squarely in Georgia's Bible Belt, where Protestant Christianity has shaped community life for generations. Robins Air Force Base has added meaningful diversity, ensuring families of many faiths find a place to belong.

Protestant Christianity

Protestant Christianity is by far the dominant faith presence in Warner Robins, with dozens of active congregations spread throughout Houston County. From small neighborhood chapels to large contemporary campuses, there is a wide range of worship styles and traditions to explore.



Major Denominations

Southern Baptist, United Methodist, Presbyterian, Lutheran, Assemblies of God, Church of God, and Seventh-day Adventist congregations are all represented.



Worship Styles

Services range from traditional hymn-based worship with choirs and pipe organs to modern contemporary services with live bands and multimedia presentations.



Multicultural Congregations

Korean and Chinese Baptist congregations also serve the area, reflecting the international character of the military and professional community.

Catholic: Sacred Heart Catholic Church

Sacred Heart Catholic Church is the only Catholic parish in Warner Robins and a cornerstone of the local Catholic community. Founded in 1945 and part of the Diocese of Savannah, it has a long history of serving both longtime residents and newly arrived military families.

Sacred Heart offers Mass in both English and Spanish, making it especially welcoming to the area's growing Hispanic community. The parish also operates Sacred Heart Catholic School, providing faith-based education from pre-K through middle school.

Islam: Islamic Center of Middle Georgia

The **Islamic Center of Middle Georgia (ICMG)** is the primary mosque serving Warner Robins and Houston County, located in neighboring Centerville at **2501 Elberta Road**. Established as a Sunni mosque around 2000, it has grown into a vibrant community hub for Muslim families throughout the region.

Daily Prayers

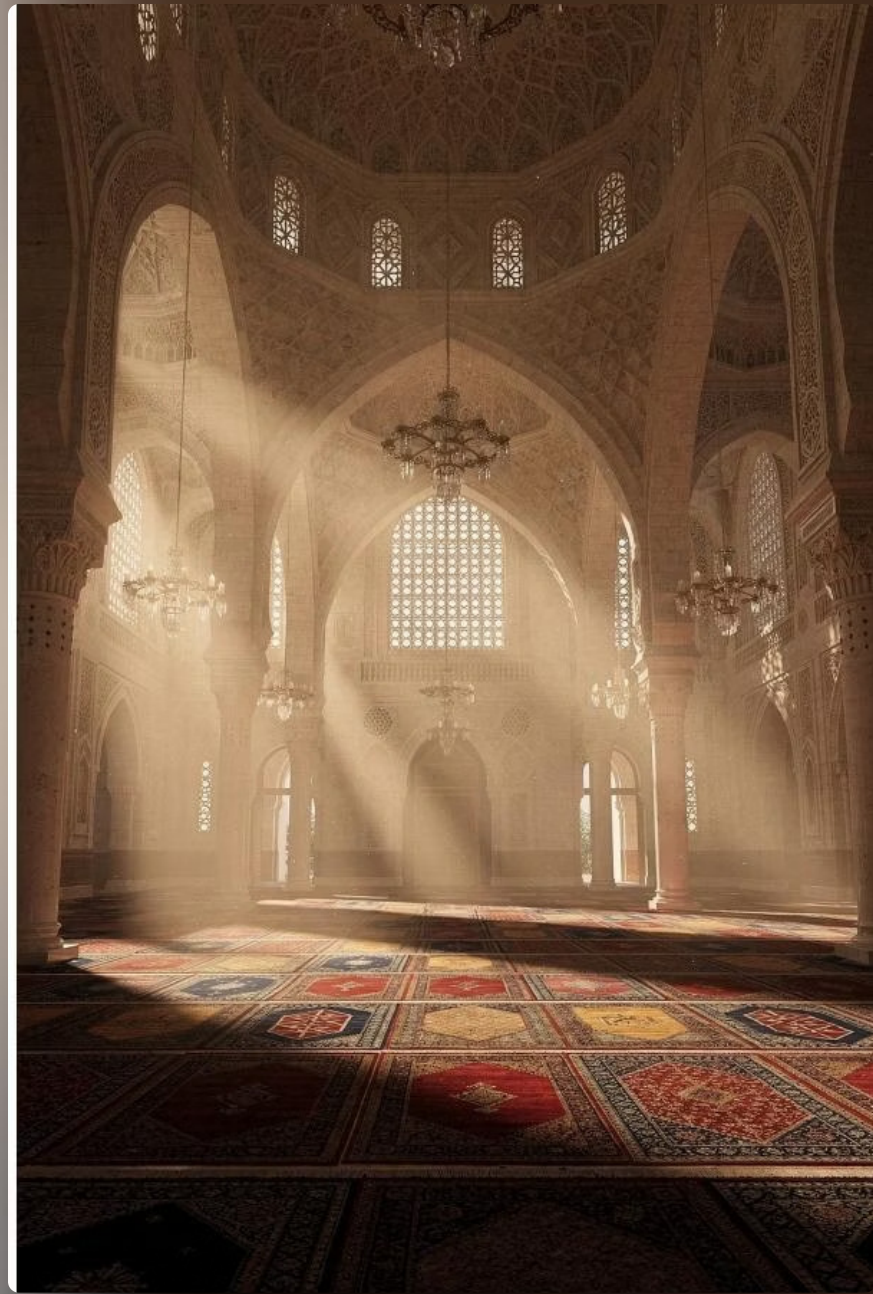
The mosque maintains all five daily prayer times, providing a consistent space for worship and reflection.

Friday Jummah

Weekly congregational Friday prayers bring the community together for worship, a sermon, and fellowship.

Judaism: Historic Congregations in Macon

Jewish worship in the wider area is centered in Macon, approximately **20 minutes north** of Warner Robins via I-75. Macon is home to two historic congregations that have served Middle Georgia's Jewish community for well over a century.



Temple Beth Israel (Reform)

Founded in 1859, one of the oldest Jewish congregations in Georgia, offering Reform worship and rich community traditions. tbimacon.org



Congregation Sha'arey Israel (Conservative)

With more than 100 years of service, Sha'arey Israel offers Conservative Jewish worship in Macon. csimacon.org

The **Jewish Federation of Macon and Middle Georgia** provides additional support, programs, and connection for Jewish families throughout the region.



Hinduism, Buddhism & Other Paths

Umiya Mataji Mandir

Located on Raley Road in Macon (~25–30 min away), this temple hosts regular worship and major Hindu festivals. umiyamataji.com

Shree Swaminarayan Mandir Loyadham

Serves the Hindu community with devotional worship and celebrations of festivals such as Diwali and Navratri. New housing near the temples makes it easier for families to live close to their place of worship.

Buddhism & Other Traditions

Local meditation and practice groups serve the area. Larger Buddhist temples serving Southeast and East Asian communities are found in metro Atlanta, ~90 minutes north on I-75. Additional faith communities continue to form across the broader Warner Robins and Macon metro area.

Visitors Are Always Welcome

The vast majority of congregations warmly welcome first-time visitors. Many have dedicated **military and newcomer ministries** to help relocating families feel at home.

Don't Forget Macon

Macon is only **20 minutes north** via I-75 and dramatically expands your options, particularly for Catholic, Jewish, Muslim, Hindu, and other non-Protestant communities.

Check Websites and Call Ahead

Service times change seasonally. Always verify current schedules before your first visit.

Many congregations offer livestreamed services — a great way to explore communities and find the right fit before attending in person.
