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WARNER ROBINS, GA

Warner Robins

Home of the planes, trains, and heroes — and the hub for family fun in Houston County. Warner Robins packs an impressive lineup of activities for every age, from world-class aviation history to water parks and indoor play centers.



Museum of Aviation

One of the largest aviation museums in the country — over 85 historic aircraft across four exhibit buildings, a VR flight simulator, and free STEM camps for kids. **Free admission.** Open Mon–Sat.



Rigby's Entertainment Complex

The ultimate one-stop play destination — bowling, skating, two-level laser tag, arcade games, outdoor go-karts, and 19-hole mini-golf. A full day of fun under one roof.



Rigby's Water World

A full water park with thrill slides, a lazy river, a lagoon, kiddie play areas, and shaded cabanas — perfect for beating the Georgia heat with the whole family.



Ted Wright Park

Warner Robins' first ADA-compliant park, with a wheelchair-friendly splash pad, modern playground, ball fields, and basketball, tennis, pickleball, and volleyball courts. Open daily, free to all.

Monkey Joe's

Indoor inflatable fun for kids ages 2–12, with a dedicated toddler zone.

Wellston Trail

Scenic walking and biking trail great for active family outings.

Aquatic Center

Warner Robins Aquatic Center for lap swimming and family swim sessions.

CENTERVILLE, GA

Centerville

A small, friendly community tucked right between Warner Robins and Macon, Centerville is perfect for families who want a quiet neighborhood feel with everything close by. It blends small-town warmth with unbeatable convenience.

Centerville City Park

The heart of local recreation — featuring playgrounds, ball fields, open walking areas, and community events that bring neighbors together throughout the year. It's the kind of park where kids run free and families linger.

Byron's iconic giant peach landmark off I-75 is a beloved photo stop and a true taste of Peach State pride — a must for any new family arriving in Middle Georgia. Byron's outlet shopping makes for an easy family pit stop, and seasonal festivals bring the whole community together throughout the year.

PERRY, GA

Perry

The Crossroads of Georgia — full of wholesome, hands-on family experiences just south of Warner Robins. Perry punches well above its size when it comes to family-friendly attractions, events, and community spirit.



Go Fish Education Center

A 170,000-gallon journey through Georgia's rivers and swamps, featuring live fish, turtles, alligators, fishing and hunting simulators, and a stocked casting pond where kids can experience real fishing. Located at **1255 Perry Parkway, Perry, GA.**



Georgia National Fairgrounds

Home of the beloved Georgia National Fair each fall, plus year-round events including concerts, livestock shows, dog shows, fireworks displays, and family festivals that draw visitors from across the state.



Parks & Community Fun

Enjoy Rozar Park, Creekwood Park and Splashpad, and Heritage Oaks Park. Catch a live show at Perry Players Community Theatre, or take a leisurely stroll through charming Historic Downtown Perry for a treat and a memory.

MACON, GA

Macon

Just a short drive north of Warner Robins, Macon is packed with world-class attractions for every age — from 12,000-year-old history to live minor league baseball, all within easy reach for a great family day trip.

Ocmulgee Mounds National Historical Park

Climb the Great Temple Mound, step inside an ancient earthen lodge, and explore 12,000 years of American Indian history through hands-on exhibits and miles of scenic trails. Kids earn a Junior Ranger badge.

Free admission, open daily.

Museum of Arts & Sciences

Georgia's largest museum of its kind — featuring a full planetarium, a mini-zoo with 70+ animals, the incredible 40-million-year-old "Ziggy" whale fossil, and hands-on art and science exhibits kids absolutely love.

Amerson River Park

A stunning 180-acre park along the Ocmulgee River with seven miles of trails, an all-abilities playground, and kayaking, canoeing, and tubing on the water — perfect for an active family adventure.

Cheer on the Macon Bacon at a fun, affordable minor league baseball game, explore the Tubman Museum, test skills at the Georgia Sports Hall of Fame, jump at Sky Zone, or spend the day at Lake Tobesofkee.
